NOTICE

Important Information Regarding Driving-Under-the-Influence Completion Certificates (DL 101)

Any person(s) involved in the acceptance of a bribe, or the solicitation of a completion certificate (DL 101), in any Driving-Under-the-Influence (DUI) program in which the person receiving the certificate does not attend, or does not complete all required components of the program, may be found guilty of a felony.

The party or parties involved may be found guilty of violating the following law...

Section 134 of the California Penal Code

Every person guilty of preparing any false or antedated book, paper, record, instrument in writing, or other matter or thing, with intent to produce it, allow it to be produced for any fraudulent or deceitful purpose, as genuine or true, upon any trial proceeding, or inquiry whatever, authorized by law, is guilty of a felony.
