STATUS LETTER REQUEST

Providing a status letter is a courtesy afforded by the program ONLY if there is a demonstrated need. San Diego County Courts generally call program for participant status. Standard reasons for providing status letters are as follows:

- 1. Participant is from an "Out of County" Court and needs to report to the court.
- 2. Extended pay participants are required to show court they have completed activities.
- 3. Participant has completed the program requirements but must be in court prior submission of the DL101.
